




Fig. 2 - Forward Power Loss Characteristics

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
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Fig. 3 - Maximum Non-Repetitive Peak Forward Surge Current




Fig. 4 - Typical Instantaneous Forward Characteristics




Fig. 5 - Typical Reverse Leakage Characteristics






Fig. 6 - Typical Junction Capacitance
